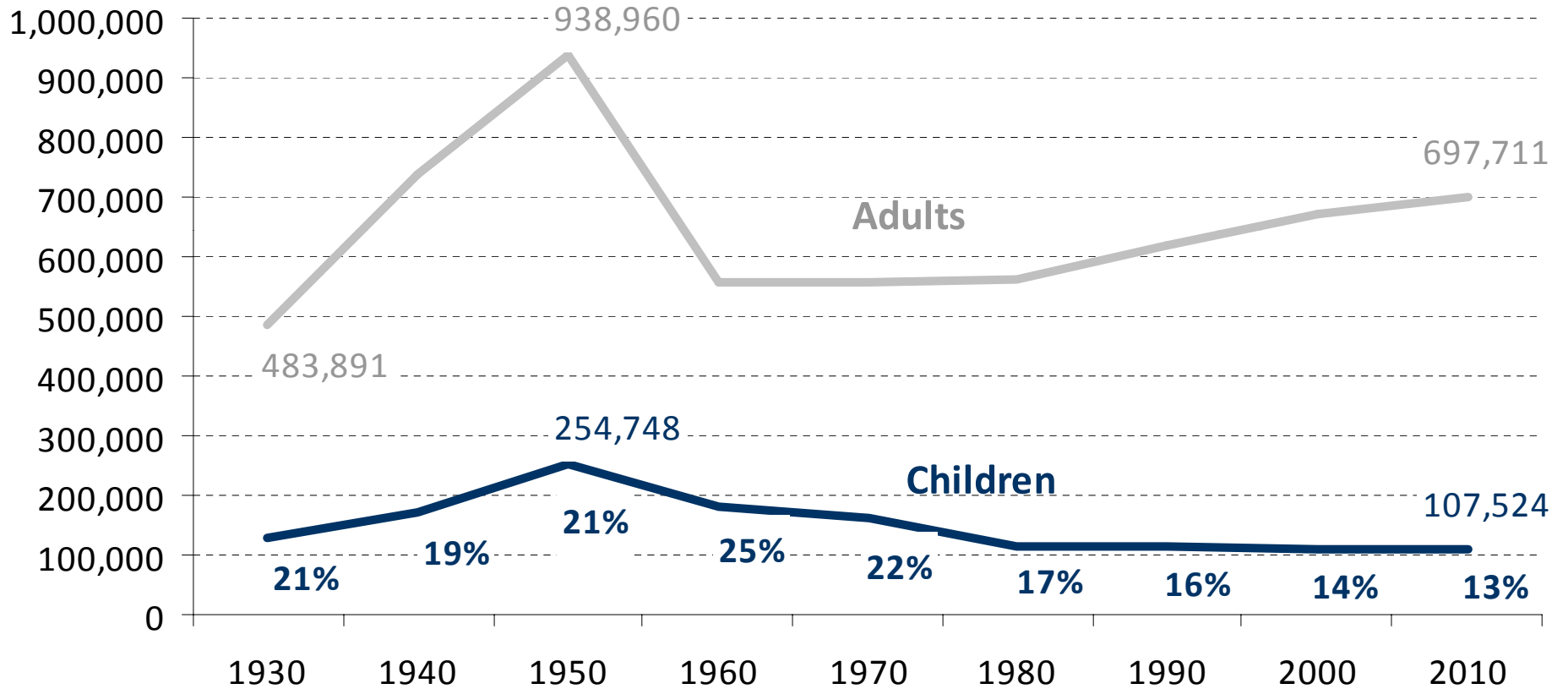

San Francisco Adult and Child Population, 1930-2010

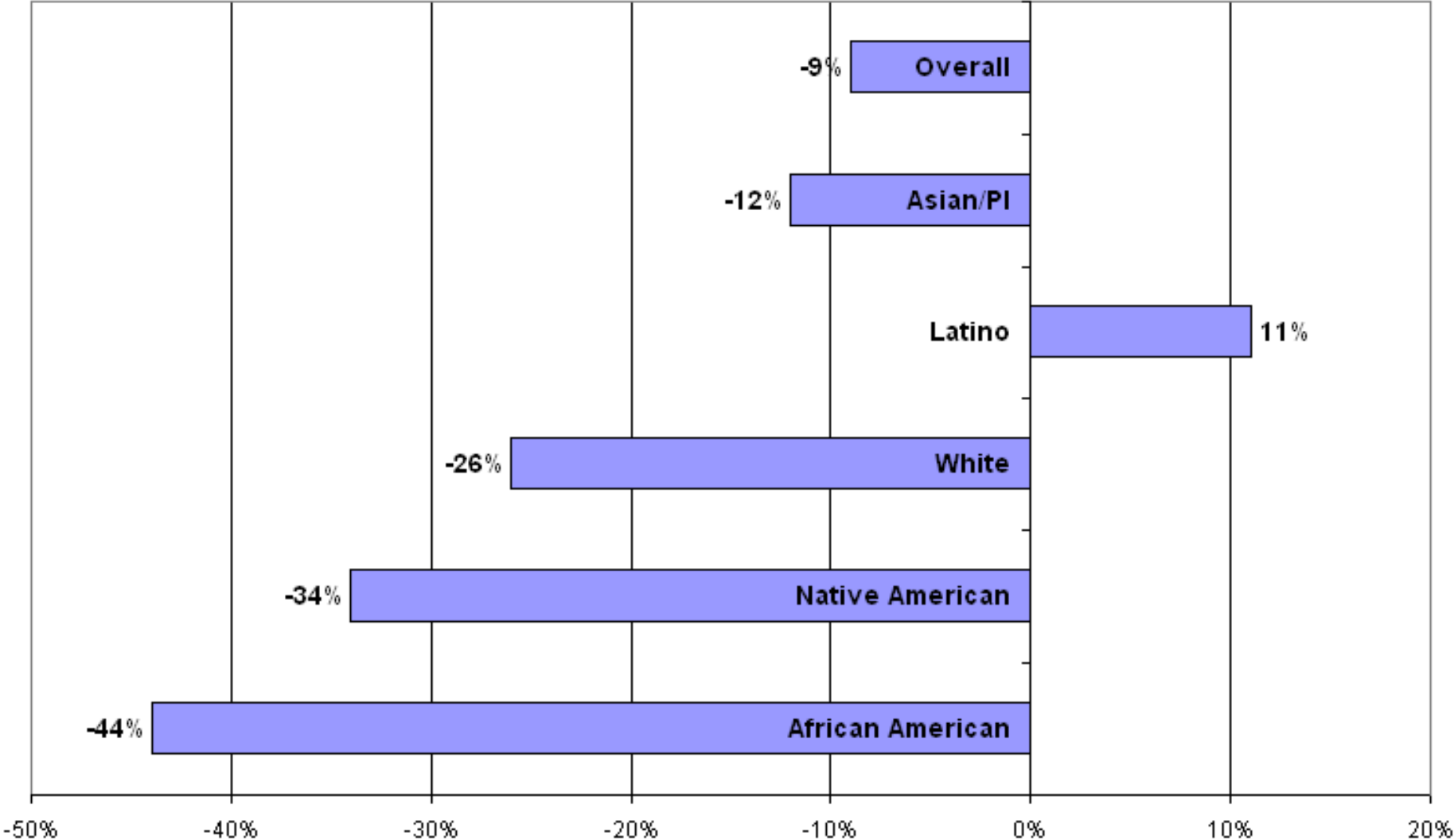

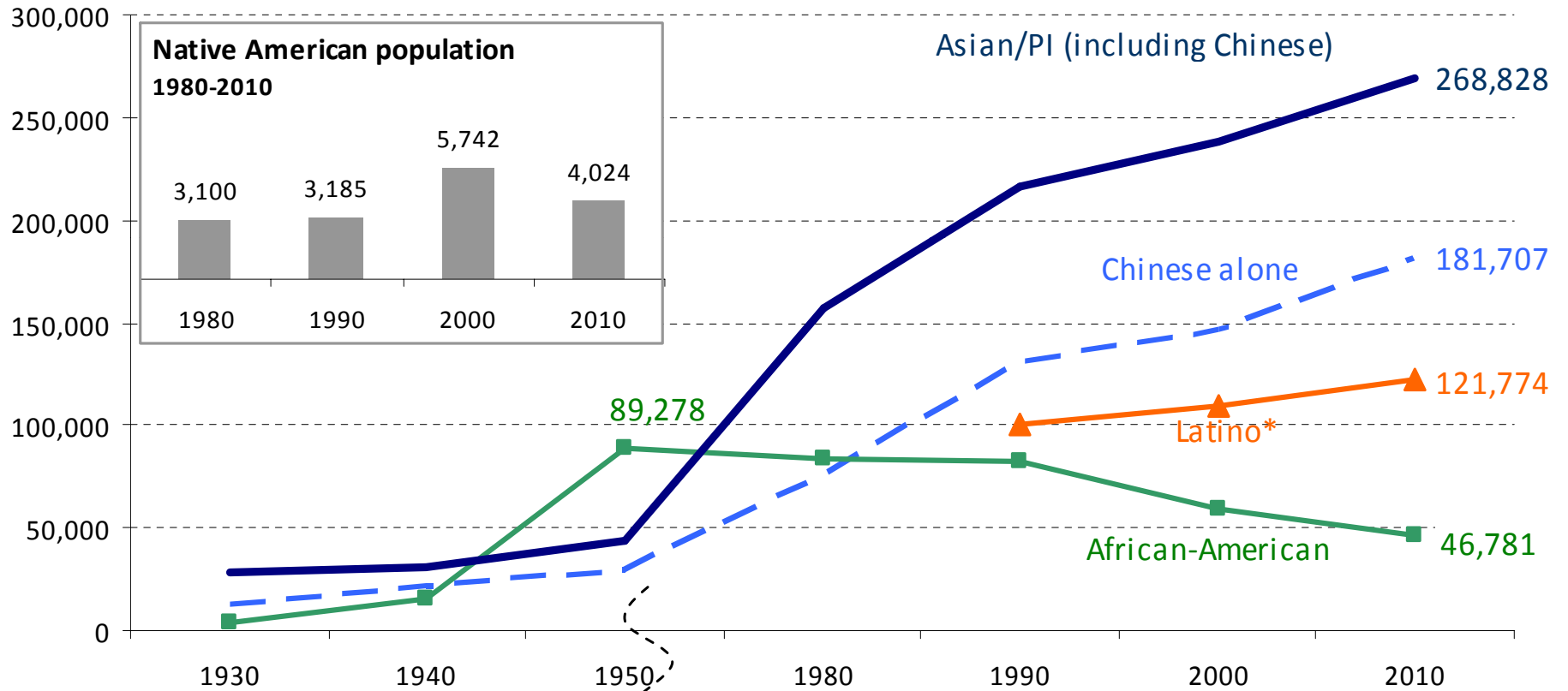
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**Changes in SFUSD Enrollment by Ethnicity
1993/94 - 2010/11**

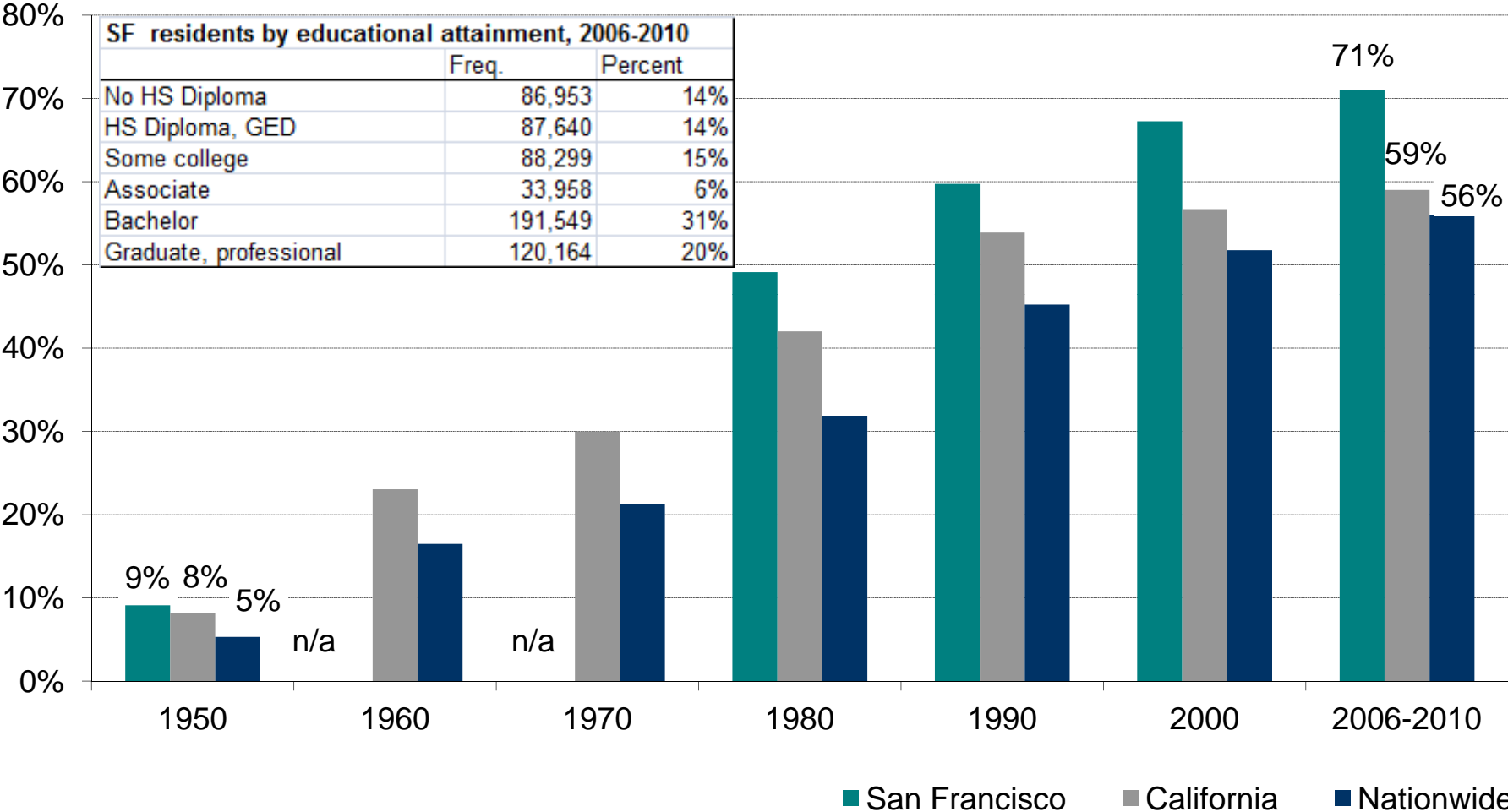


San Francisco by Largest Ethnic Minority Groups, 1930 - 2010



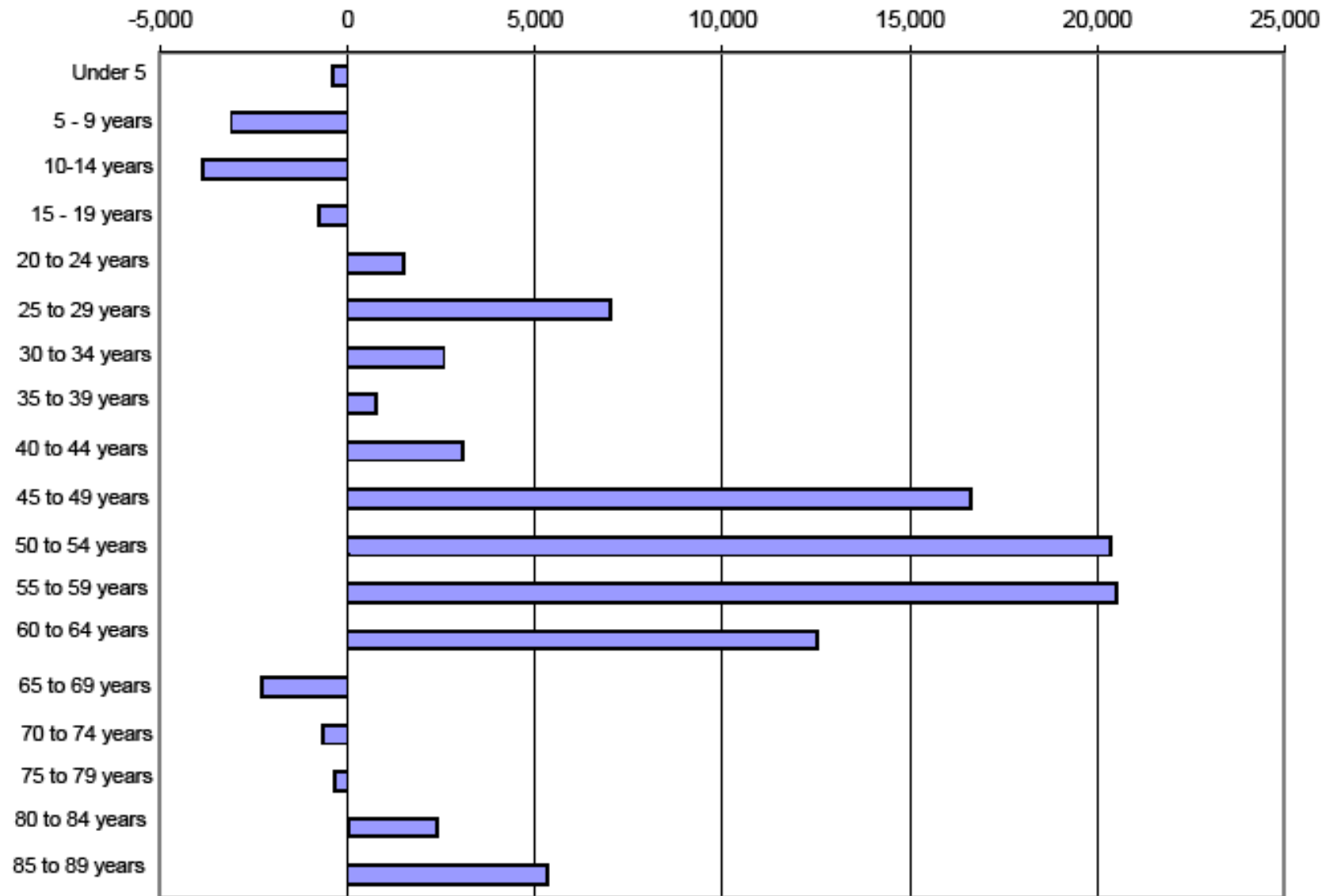

Percentage of SF, CA, and US Adults Age 25+ that Have at Least Some College Education, 1950-2010



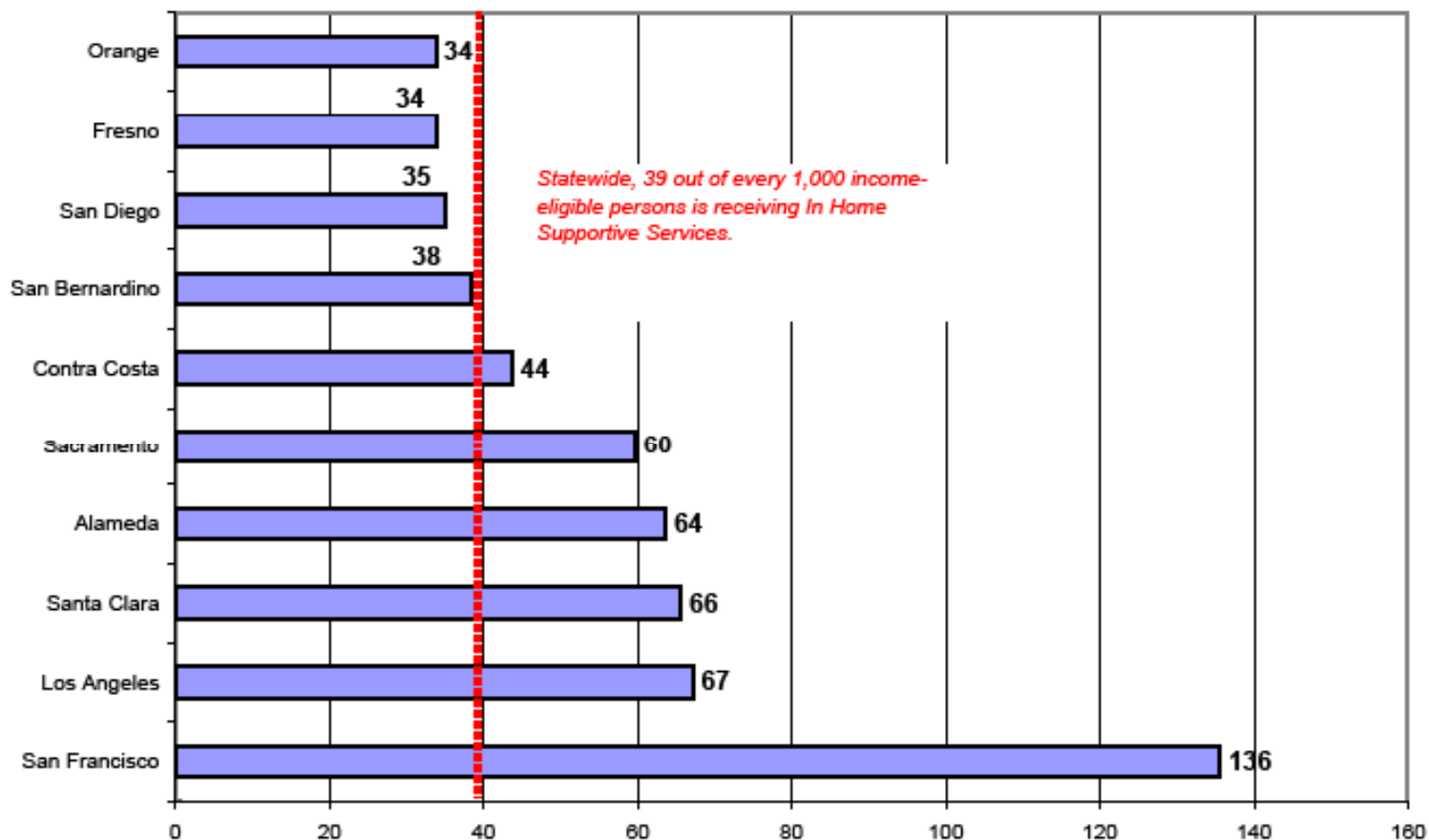

Ten Largest California Counties - December, 2009

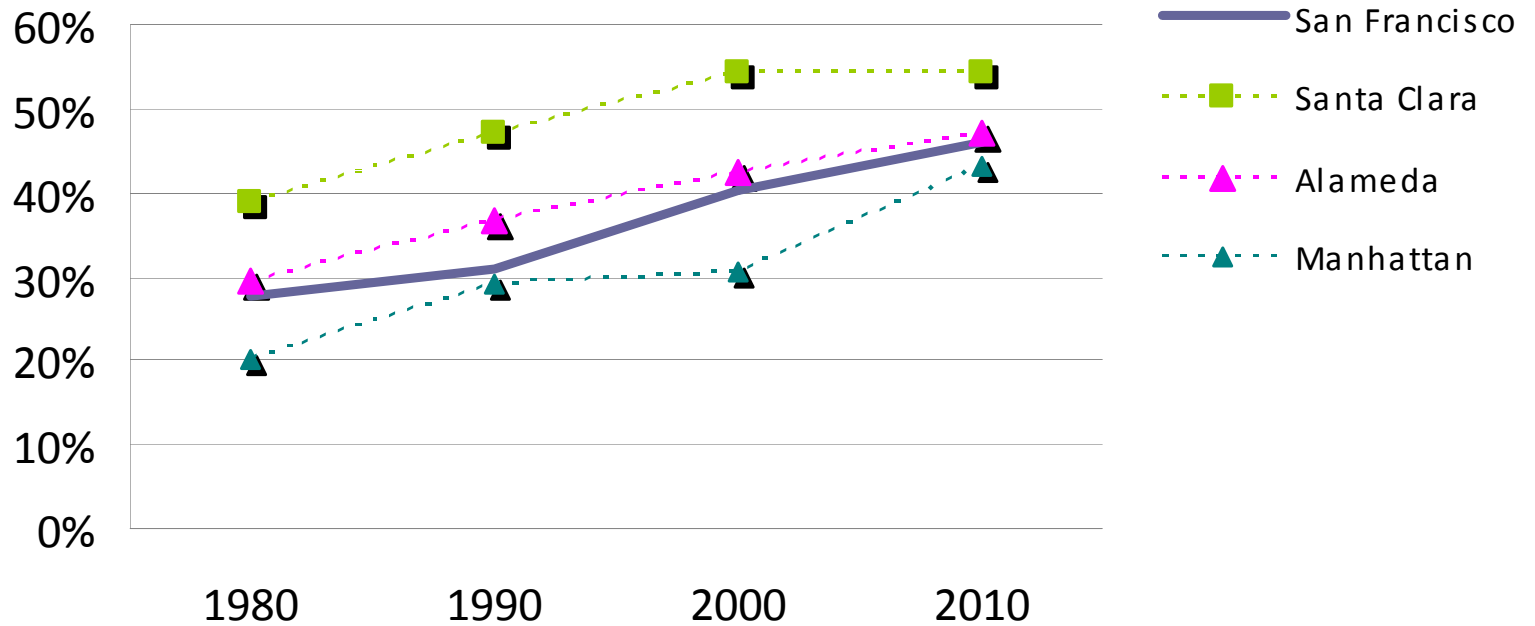

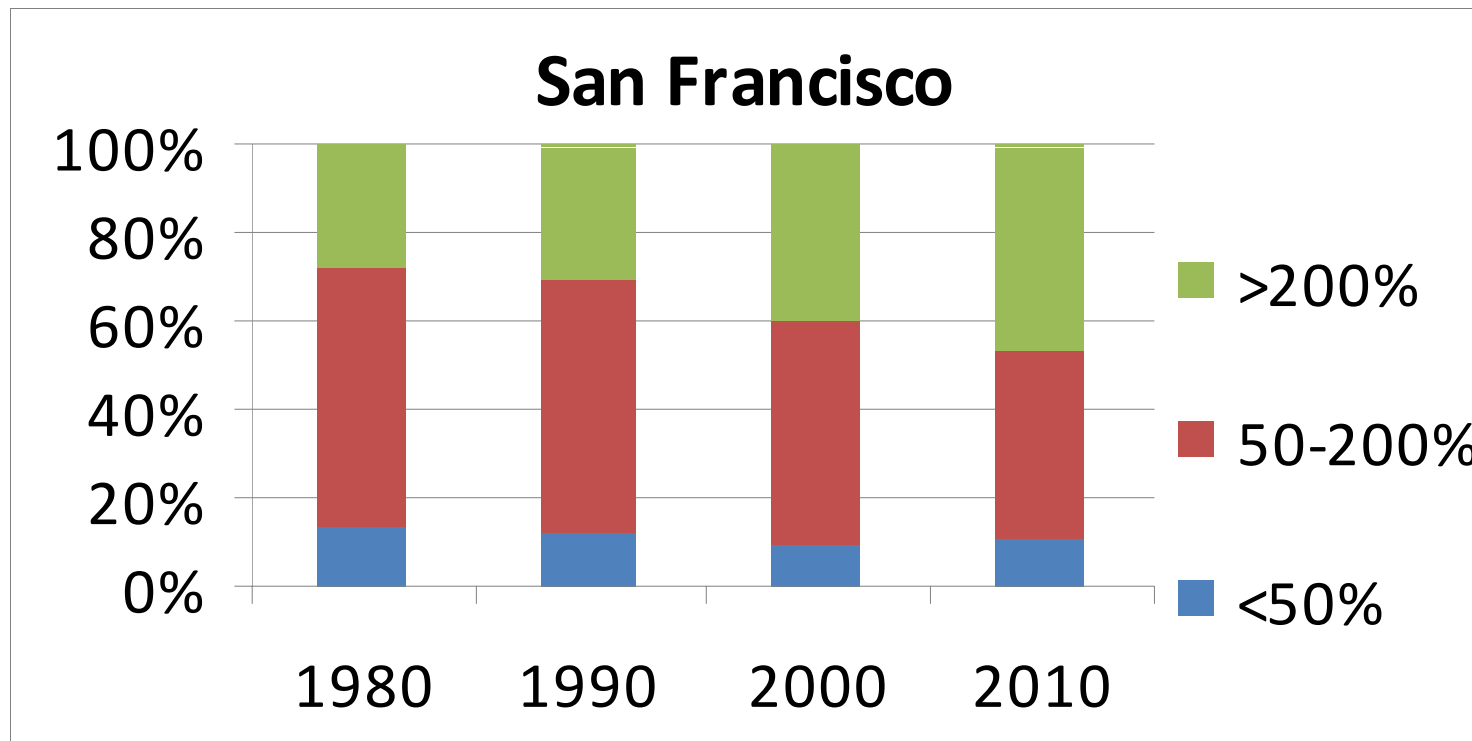
Change in Proportion of Affluent Households with Children, 1980-2010

Median

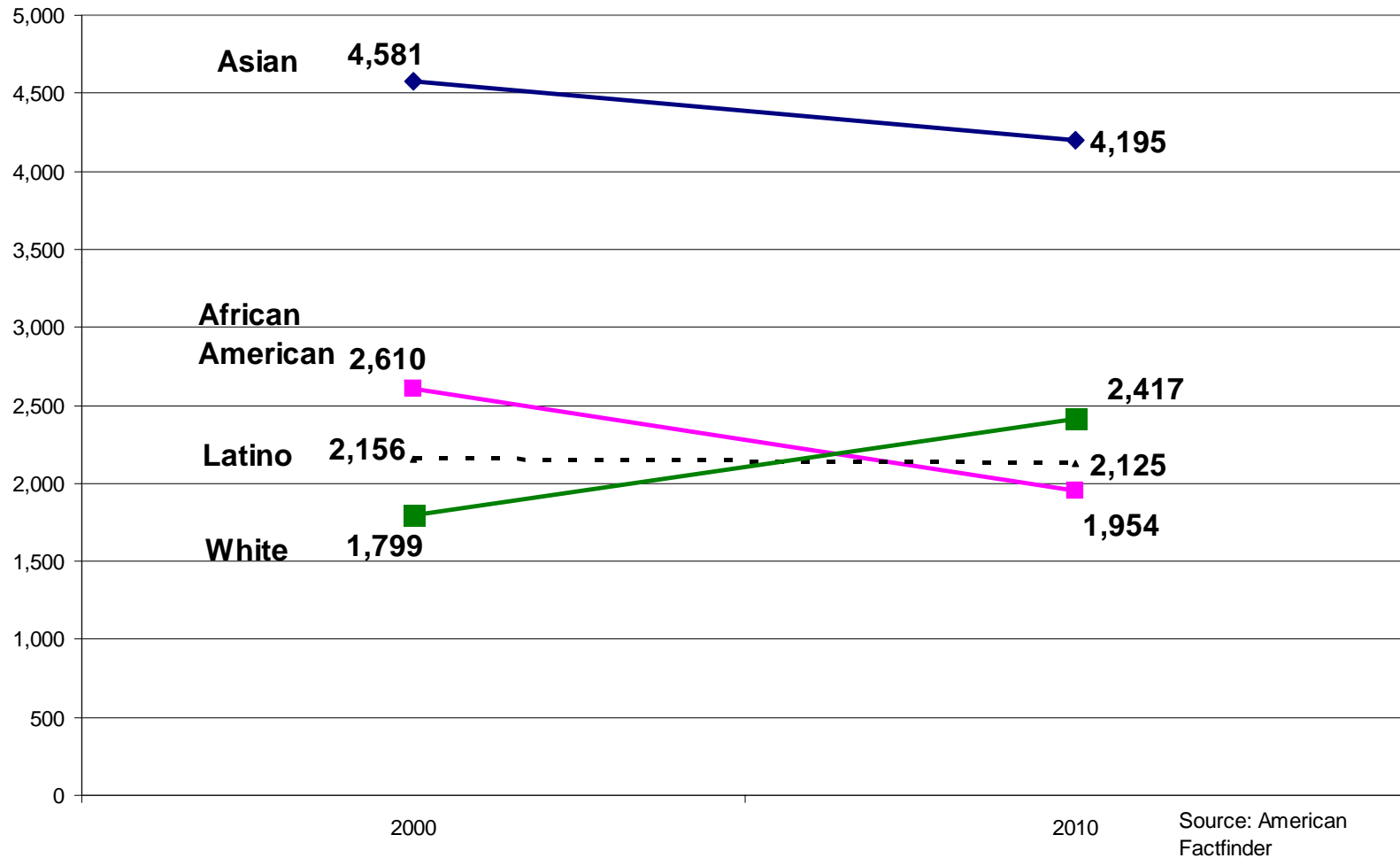

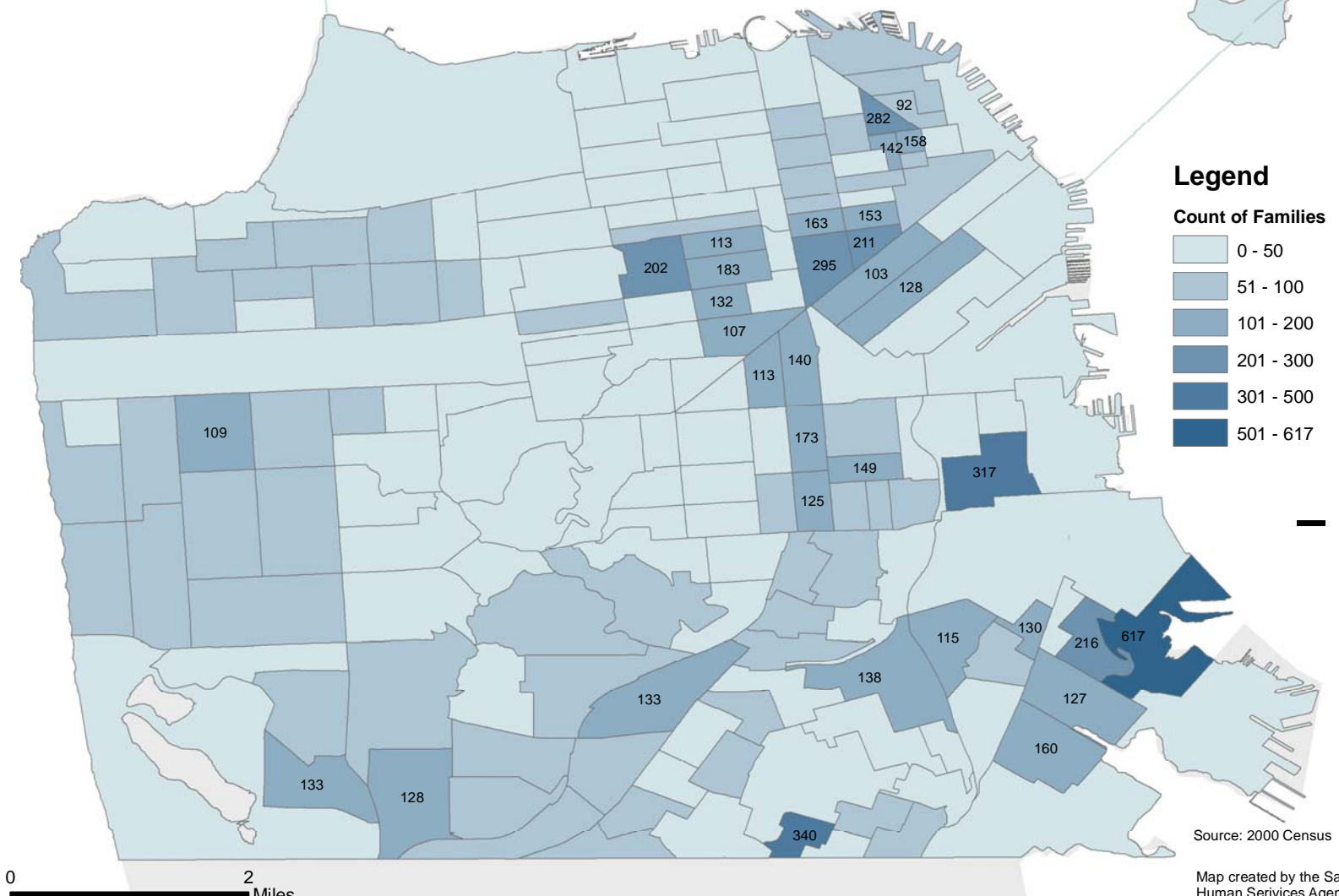
Affluent as a Proportion of San Francisco Families

San Francisco: Number of Families Living in Poverty by Census Tract, 1999

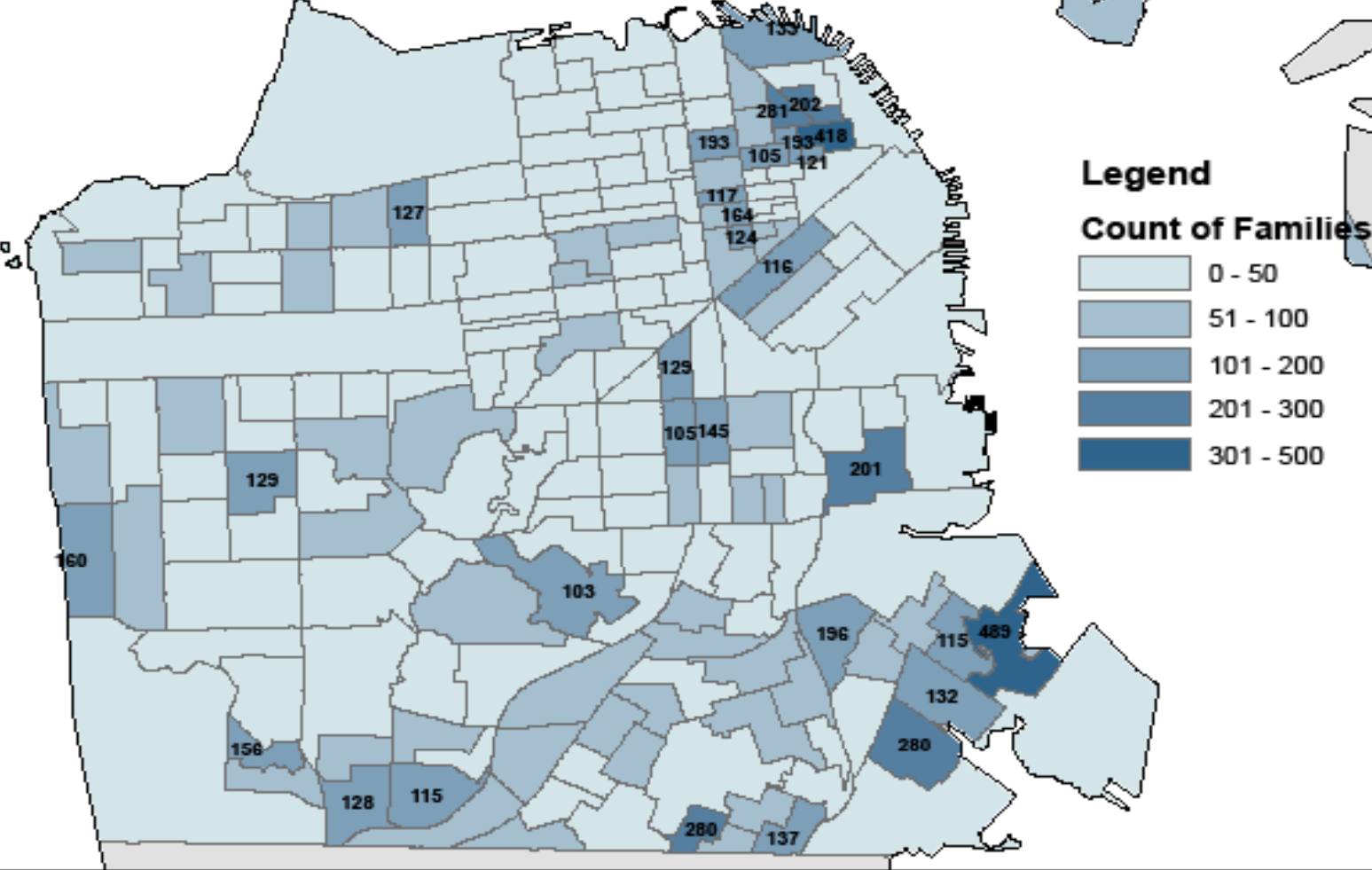

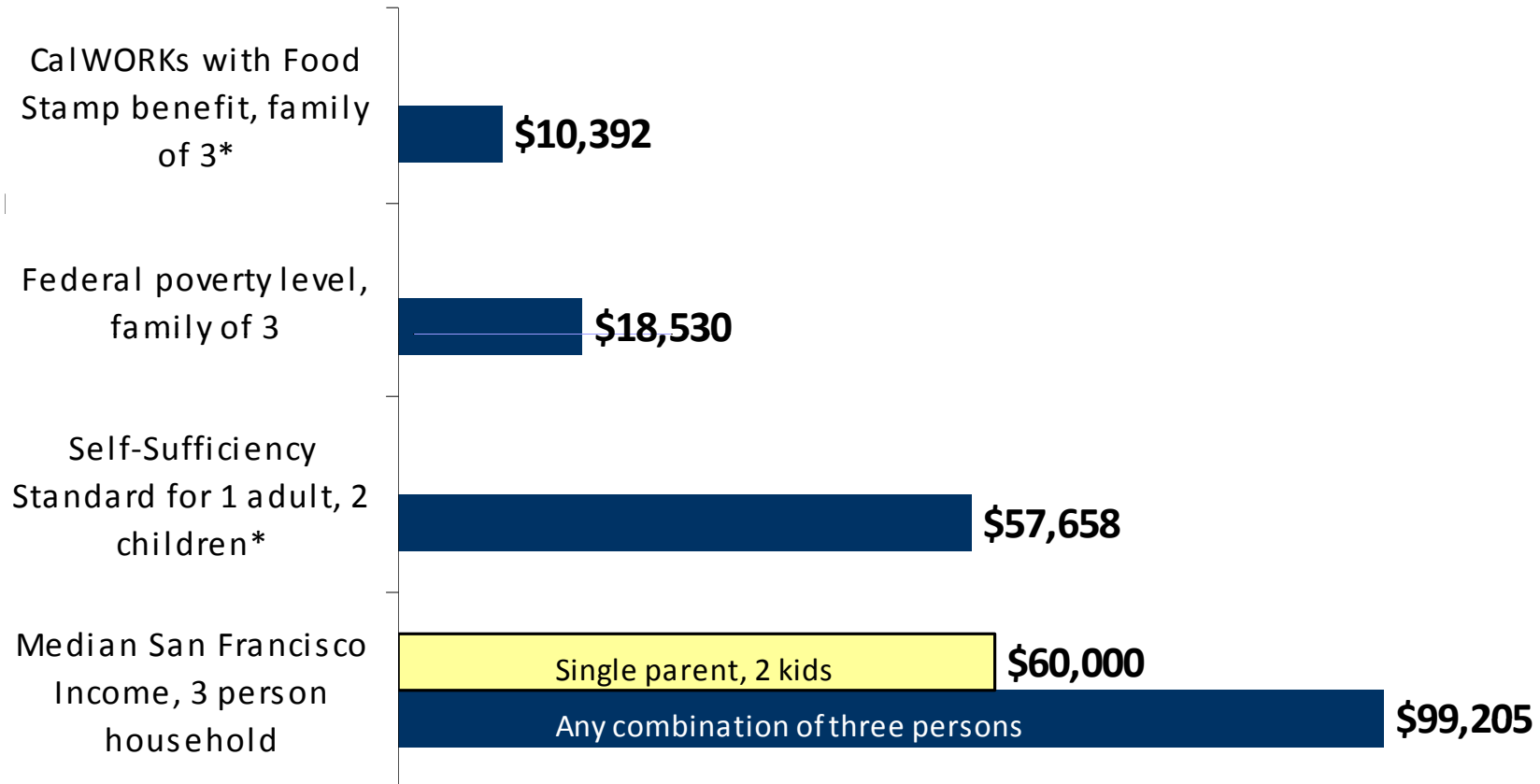

Income standards for San Francisco Families



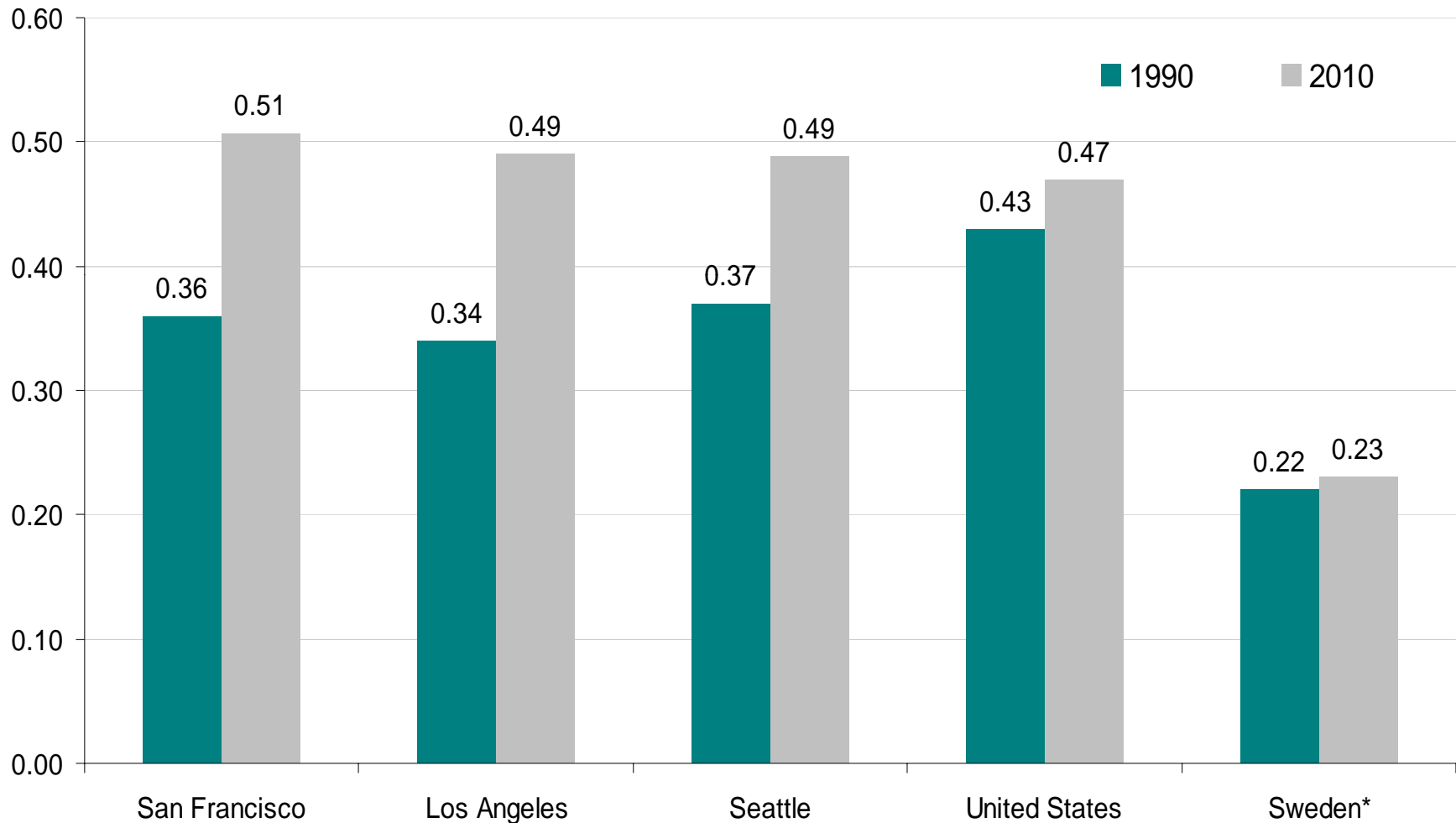

Household income Gini Coefficients 1990, 2010



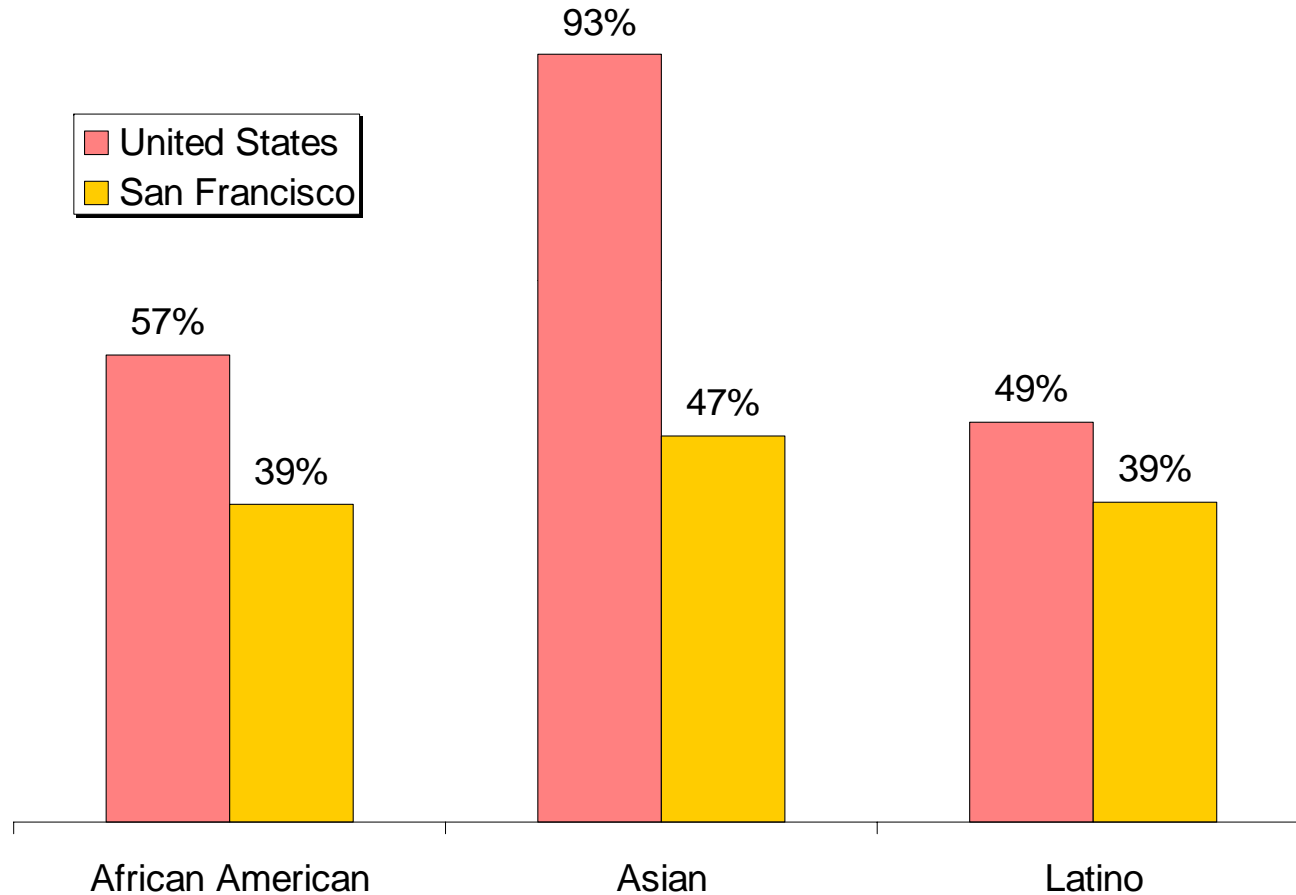

San Francisco and the United States, 2006-2010

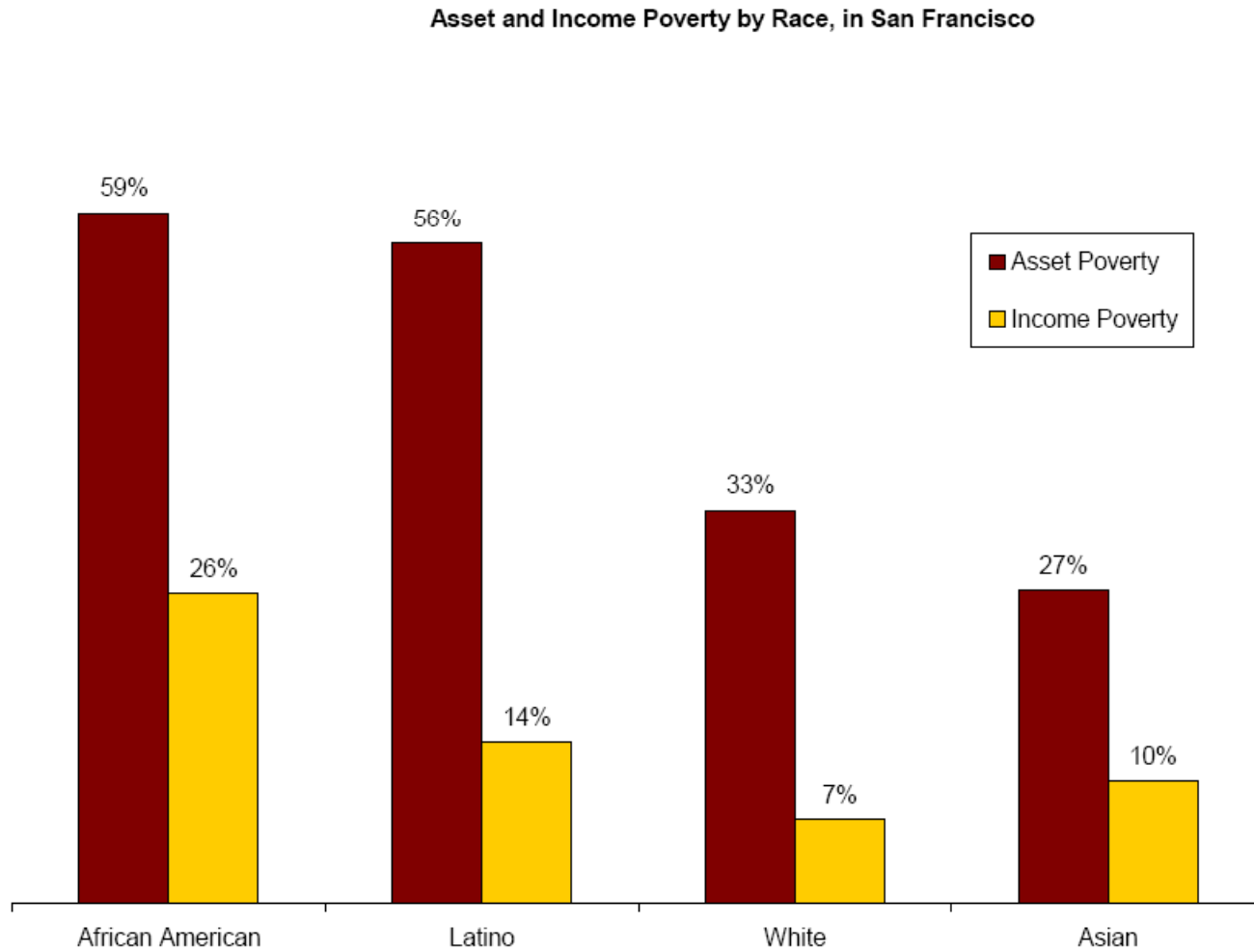

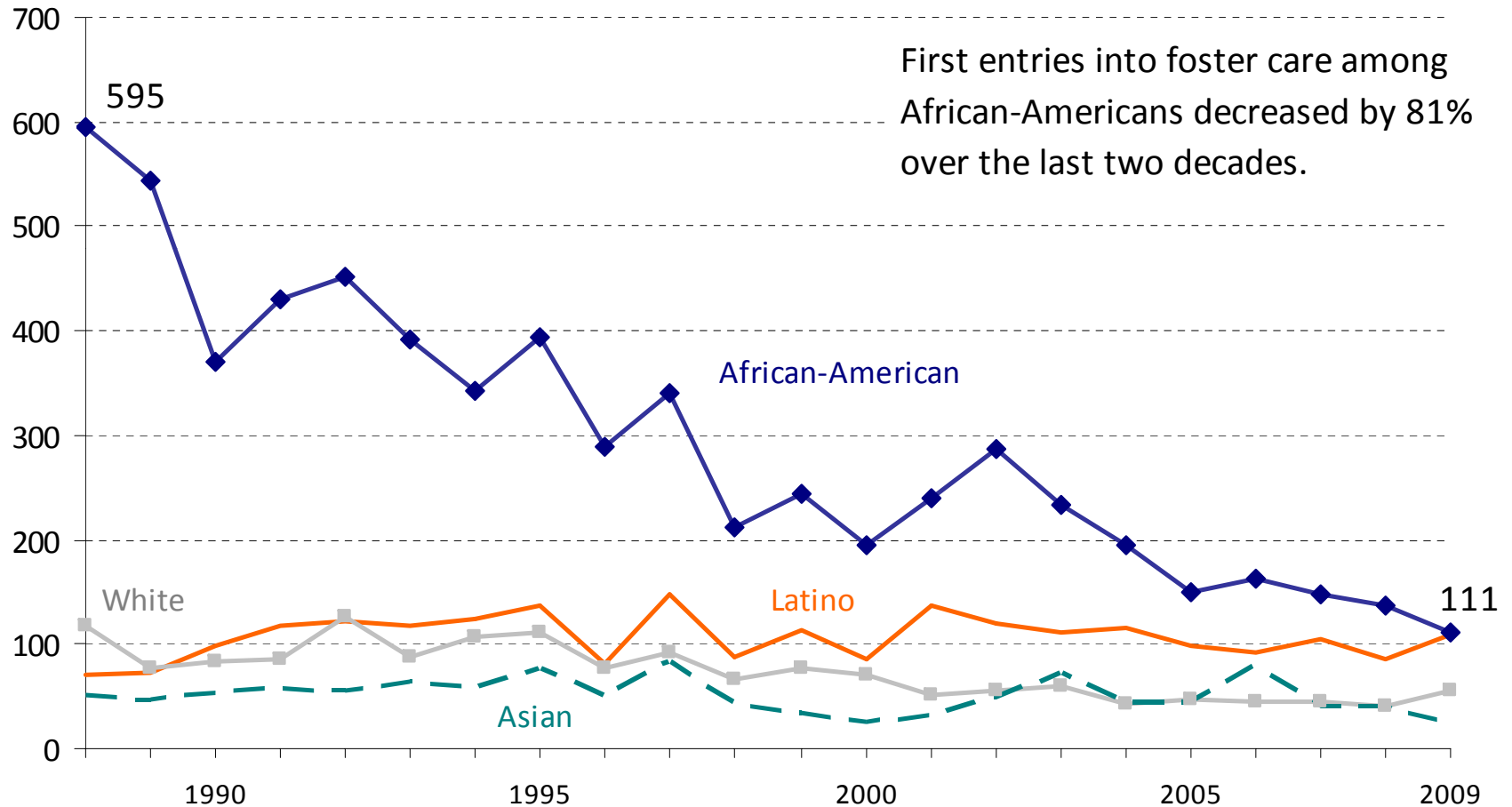

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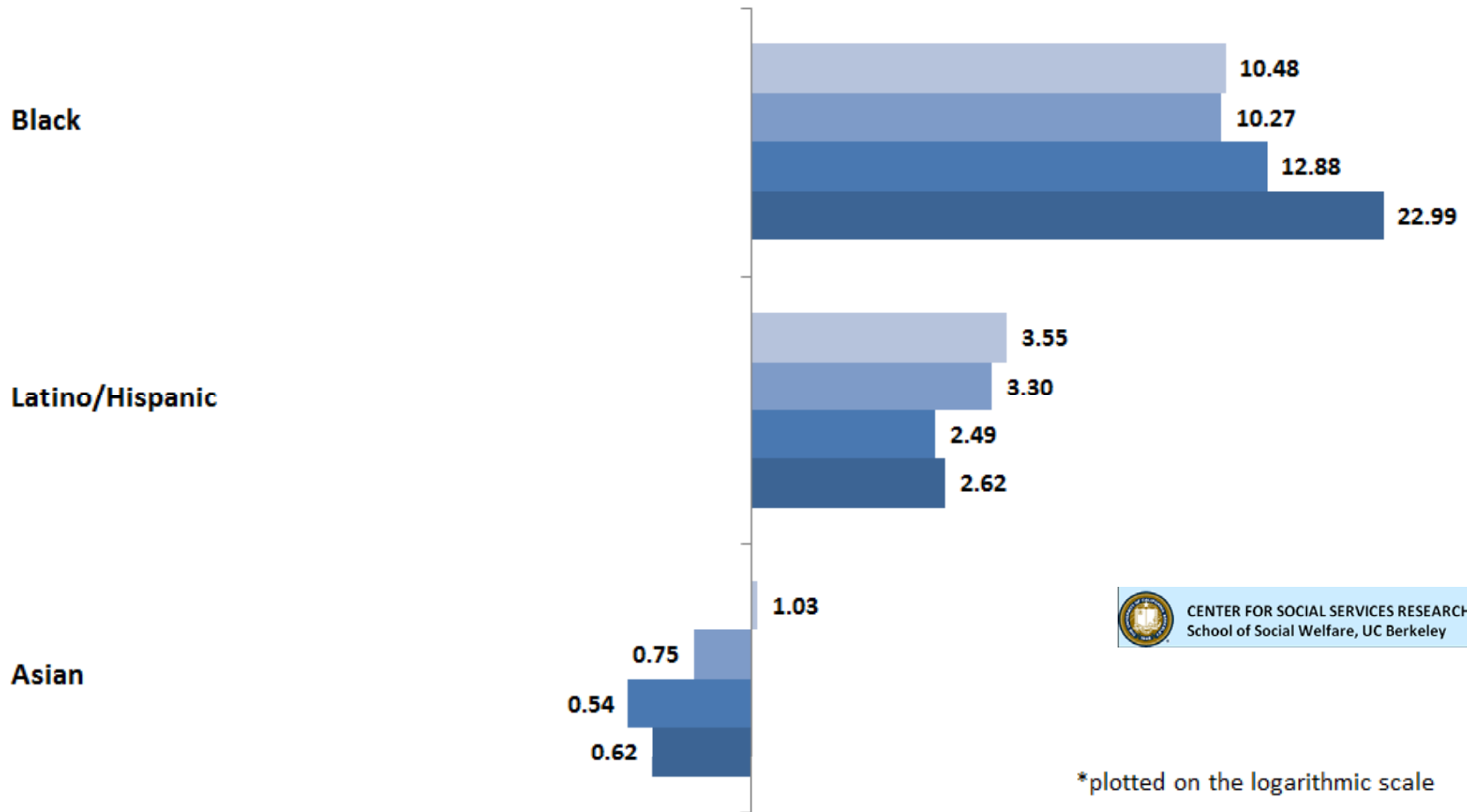
First Entries into San Francisco Foster Care by Ethnicity 1988 - 2009

San Francisco: General Population Racial Disparity Indices, 2010* (group compared to White)

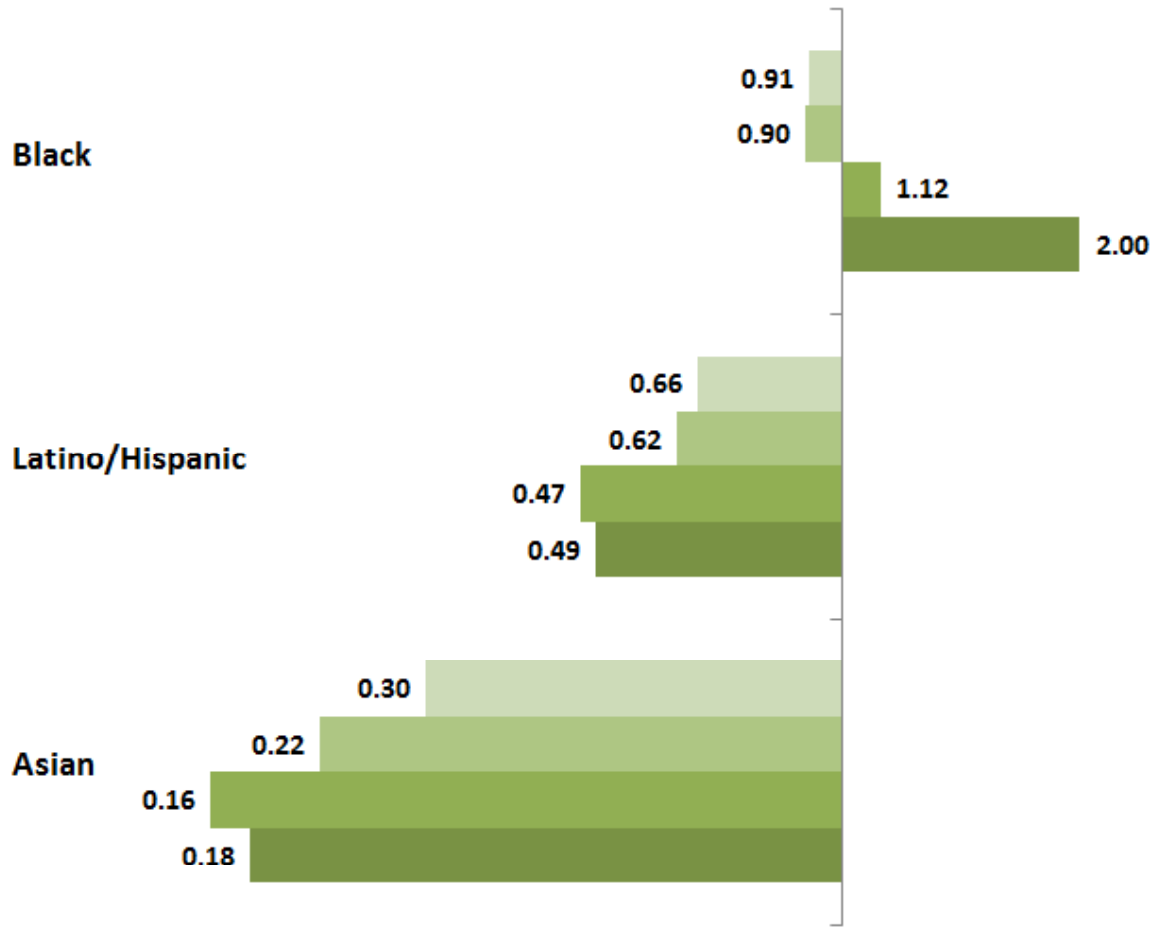
