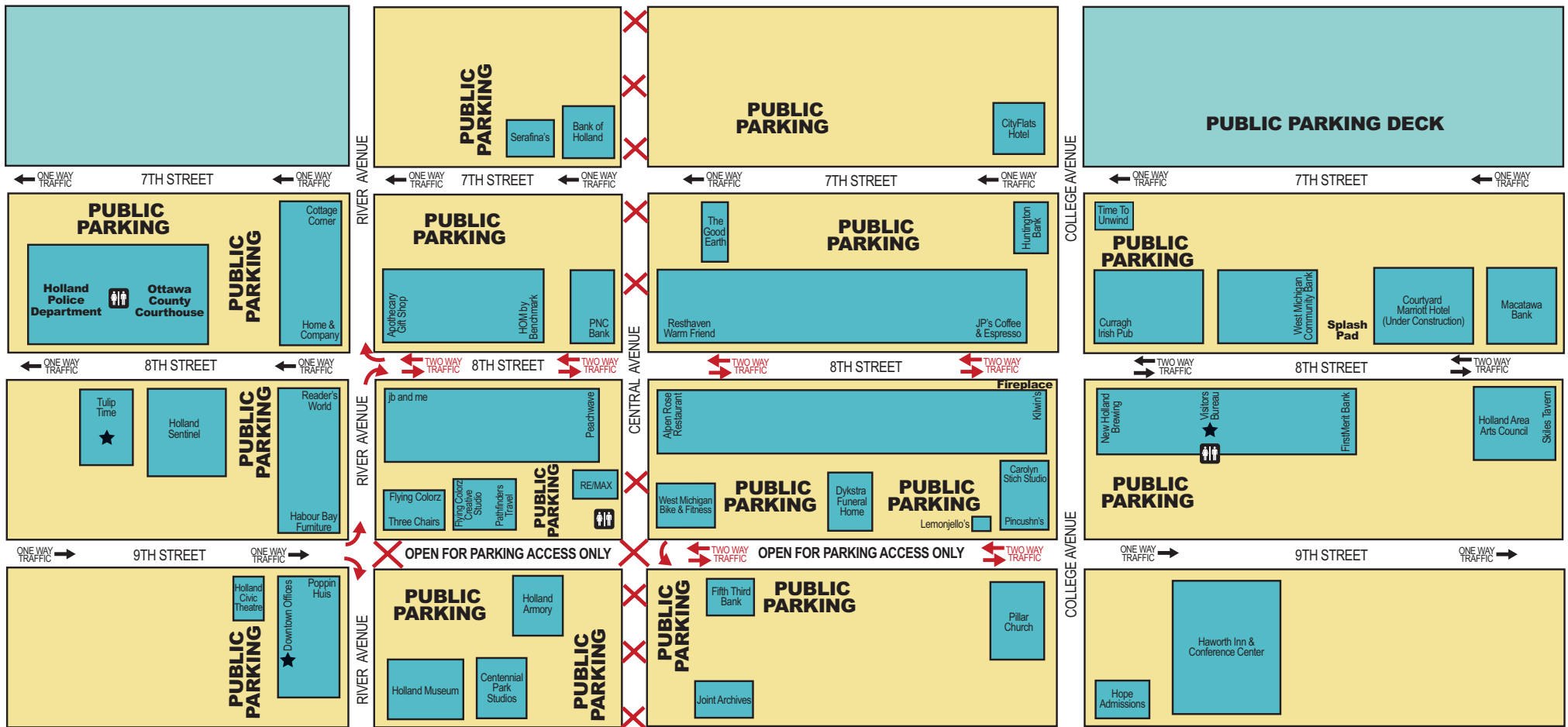


# Central Avenue Construction Information: Phase Two



## 1. Help! I'm trying to travel east! What route should I take?

To travel east, you will want to detour via 6th Street, via 8th Street (which will remain a two-way street until the intersection of 9th Street and Central Avenue is open) or via 16th Street. There is increased traffic and thus some travel delays on River Avenue due to the construction, so please plan accordingly! Please know how much we appreciate your patience and your business during this time!

## 2. How long will the construction last?

The entire Central Avenue construction project will last from early May to mid-October; however, the portion of the project affecting Downtown Holland most directly should be complete by early or mid-July.

## 3. Where can people park?

All of the parking spaces on 8th Street are accessible for vehicles traveling westbound and eastbound on 8th Street. The parking lot off of 9th Street between River Avenue and Central Avenue and on 9th Street between College Avenue and Central Avenue can be accessed by driving carefully around the barricades. 9th Street is two-way between College Avenue and Central Avenue to make accessing the parking even easier.
