

warm weather and sometimes, severe weather. Holland Board of Public Works wants to make sure you stay safe during severe weather and storms.

# CHECK OUT THE TIPS BELOW:

- 1. Stop and look around before stepping into a flooded area and be aware that submerged outlets or electrical cords may energize the water, posing a potentially deadly trap.
- 2. Stay at least 10 feet away from a downed power line and any nearby objects it may be touching.
- 3. If a downed power line lands on your vehicle or house, stay inside to stay out of the path of stray electrical current.
- 4. Never attempt to move a downed power line.
- 5. Never touch a person or object that is in direct or indirect contact with a downed power line; instead call 911 immediately.
