

**8<sup>th</sup> Grade Class Pictures**

Below are the instructions for 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents/students regarding school pictures.

\*\*\*\*\*

All students should wear dress clothes and bring a change of clothes to school. Bring a hanger and garment bag (if desired) to protect your dress clothes after you change. Students must wear appropriate dress shoes if possible and either (a) a sport coat, dress shirt, tie, long dress pants with a belt; (b) a “Sunday best” dress; or (c) a dress blouse with a dress skirt/pants.

**Arrive at school early. We would like to start taking pictures at 7:45 a.m.** 8<sup>th</sup> grade students should go to the Allen Library as soon as they are dropped off to have individual picture taken and then the class/entire grade photo.

Reminders:    Do not come to school with wet hair.  
                    Do not use too much gel as it will appear wet or greasy in the picture.  
                    If you have braces or wear glasses, decide ahead of time if you want them to  
                                 be seen in your picture.  
                    Choose your clothes carefully, make sure you like them.

**\*\* The photographer will not retake photos because of hair, braces, or bad clothing choice. \*\***

Retakes will be taken if eyes are closed or there is another obvious flaw in the picture.  
[If a student has a blemish (that cannot be well covered), fever blister, black eye, etc., individual picture may be taken on our make-up day (date to be determined). In that case, student must still come appropriately dressed on Monday, September 17<sup>th</sup> as he/she will still be part of the class picture taken that day.]

If a student must have a retake, you will receive the second photograph taken. You will not have a choice between the two. No exceptions!

Your cooperation will ensure a great photo and prevent unnecessary missed time from class.
