

## What are Community Groups?

Community Groups is a model of small groups where members are brought together by where they live rather than their stage of life. Groups contain members who live near each other and meet weekly or biweekly. By participating, Zioners have the opportunity to live life with one another, mutually spurring each other towards Christ and blessing the community in which they reside.



## Elements of a Community Group



### Study the Word

Growing in the faith through guided studies of God's Word and meaningful theological conversations.



### Prayer

Holding each other in prayer, bringing the communities requests before our Father.



### Fellowship

Building deep and meaningful relationships with other believers, encouraging and holding each other accountable as they pursue Christ.



### Service

Looking for ways to be a blessing in the congregation and the communities they meet in.

## Common Questions

### Who?

Community groups are available for all adults (18+)

### Leaders?

Each group is led by a member of ZBCC.

### Size?

We try and keep the groups between 6 and 12 people. When a group approaches 12 regular attenders, we begin the process of multiplying.

### Commitment?

Due to the relational nature of these gatherings, we ask that everyone make a commitment to regularly attend.

Some groups may meet weekly, others may be biweekly.

### Study?

The studies will vary by group, but they will center around God's Word.

### Where?

Throughout the city on different evenings.
