

Fifth Grade Supply List

- 1 two-inch 3-ring binder
- 8 tab dividers (write-on tabs) for binder
- 1 pack notebook paper: 150-sheet pack, college ruled
- 2 five-subject spiral notebooks (wide or college-ruled)
- 1 durable, soft pencil case with holes (must fit in binder)
- 2 Mead composition notebooks (100 pages sewn binding)
- 20 - 30 #2 wooden pencils (not mechanical pencils; at least 5 sharpened on first day)
- 15 - 25 eraser caps
- plastic pencil sharpener with receptacle
- 2 highlighters (2 different colors)
- 1 package of colored pencils (8-12 count)
- 1 black, ultra fine-point Sharpie
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 roll Scotch tape
- 1 set headphones/earbuds (to be kept at school)
- 1 small dry erase board
- 2-4 dry erase markers
- 1 personal sized container of UNSCENTED hand sanitizer
- 1 inexpensive vinyl tablecloth for use in sitting on the ground outside (label with student's first and last name)
- [Small rolling backpack](#)*
- [Soft sided lunchbox](#)* to hold supplies
- Each student should wear a clean mask daily, with 2 extra, clean masks in a sealed bag (zip lock style) in his/her backpack. Each mask should be labeled with the student's first and last name
