



RESPONDING TO KNOWN COVID-19 EXPOSURE

Based on current CDC and VDH guidance, St M will contact trace and determine if close contact occurred. All final COVID protocol responses are at the discretion of Nurse Maben and Mr. Gregg.

If **close contact** determined...
do you have symptoms?

NO

YES

If fully vaccinated

- Complete St M's COVID Reporting Form
- May come to school for in-person learning, but must **FIRST** be cleared by Nurse Maben
- Must get negative rapid or PCR test **5** days after exposure and send test results to Nurse
- Wear a mask indoors/in public for **14** days or until negative test result

If NOT fully vaccinated

- Complete St M's COVID Reporting Form
- Must **STAY HOME**
- Must get rapid or PCR test on Day **5** and send test results to Nurse
- If negative test results, may return to school on Day **8** once cleared by Nurse Maben.
- If you decide not to test, you may return to school on Day **11**.

For **BOTH** vaccinated and unvaccinated

- Complete St M's COVID Reporting Form
- **STAY HOME** and isolate for **10** days.
- Once cleared by Nurse Maben, you may return to school on Day **11** if no fever for at least 24 hours without medication & all signs of illness improving

If COVID-test result **POSITIVE** |
(regardless of vaccination status) |

- Complete St M's COVID Reporting Form
- Stay home and isolate for **10** days
- Isolate from others at home regardless of vaccination status
- Consult your doctor
- Use a separate sleeping space, utensils, and avoid common areas as much as possible
- Send a copy of test results to Nurse Maben
- Once cleared by Nurse Maben, you may return to school on Day **11** if no fever for least 24 hours without medication & all signs of illness improving
